



The 2016 SOCAP Australia Lifetime Achievement Award

Overview of the Award

The award is intended to provide:

- An important and prominent focus on best practice consumer affairs initiatives and achievements consistent with SOCAP Australia objectives
- A positive role model/s for those involved in private and public sector consumer affairs,
- and Formal peer recognition of a lifetime (10 years plus) of significant achievement, contribution and commitment to the consumer affairs industry by a SOCAP member

Pre Selection Criteria

The Lifetime Achievement Award nominee must be (or have been in the past):

- A SOCAP Australia financial member
- Have a significant record of contribution to the development of consumer affairs in Australia over 10 years or more

Note: Members of the SOCAP Australia Board or Awards Committee are not eligible for nomination

Nominations

- You may be nominated by a current SOCAP Australia member
- You may be nominated by the SOCAP Australia Board



Your nomination must address the following

1. Purpose: Why the nominee is a worthy recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award?
2. Scope: What body of work in consumer affairs has been done by the nominee?
3. Significance: - Explain the significance and impact to industry of the body of work.

Note: The nomination for the *Lifetime Achievement Award* will be limited to 600 words.

2016 Judging Panel

- The nominations will be judged by the SOCAP Australia Industry Awards Judging Panel which comprises of four SOCAP Australia Board members, three Award Committee members and the SOCAP Australia Chief Executive Officer
- The Judging Panel will provide a shortlist plus recommended winner to the SOCAP Australia Board for final endorsement
- The Secretariat of SOCAP Australia will oversee the administration of the judging process

- SOCAP Australia 2016 Industry Awards nominations close COB 31 July 2016
- Week commencing Monday 1 August 2016 – Judges decision and voting
- Tuesday 23 August 2016 – Award presentation at the SOCAP Symposium Gala Dinner and Industry Awards Night, at The Langham Hotel, Melbourne
